CONTEGO - the re-attachable socket with integrated cable channels is both a space-saver and a decorative feature

For many years, new products from Profloor Technology have regularly caused an international sensation in the specialist floor-laying trade. Cables disappear

At the core of Contego is a plastic component holding three independent cable channels. This allows cables carrying electrical power, TV and telephone cables to be laid cleanly and separately; tripping hazards become a thing of the past. The plastic unit screws simply and automatically at the correct height to the wall, and the cables take their proper place in each of the three trays. The cable holders terminate in a special socket made of silver-coloured, anodised aluminium, which fits onto the plug-in system in the plastic unit fitted to the wall. This hidden fitting has no visible screws and converts the aluminium socket into a pure design element to suit modern spaces.

Easy compensation for differences in level

As if the triple cable channel socket was not enough innovation for the creative design engineers at Profloor Technology, Contego also provides a solution once and for all for the familiar problem of those sunken and uneven areas that develop in new floors, causing badly-fitted sockets. A clever integral plug-in system, in which the rear-facing plastic component and the aluminium terminal engage simply with each other, means that the socket can be re-attached so that it sits perfectly on the floor once more, even if the new sub-floor has developed differences in level over the course of time.

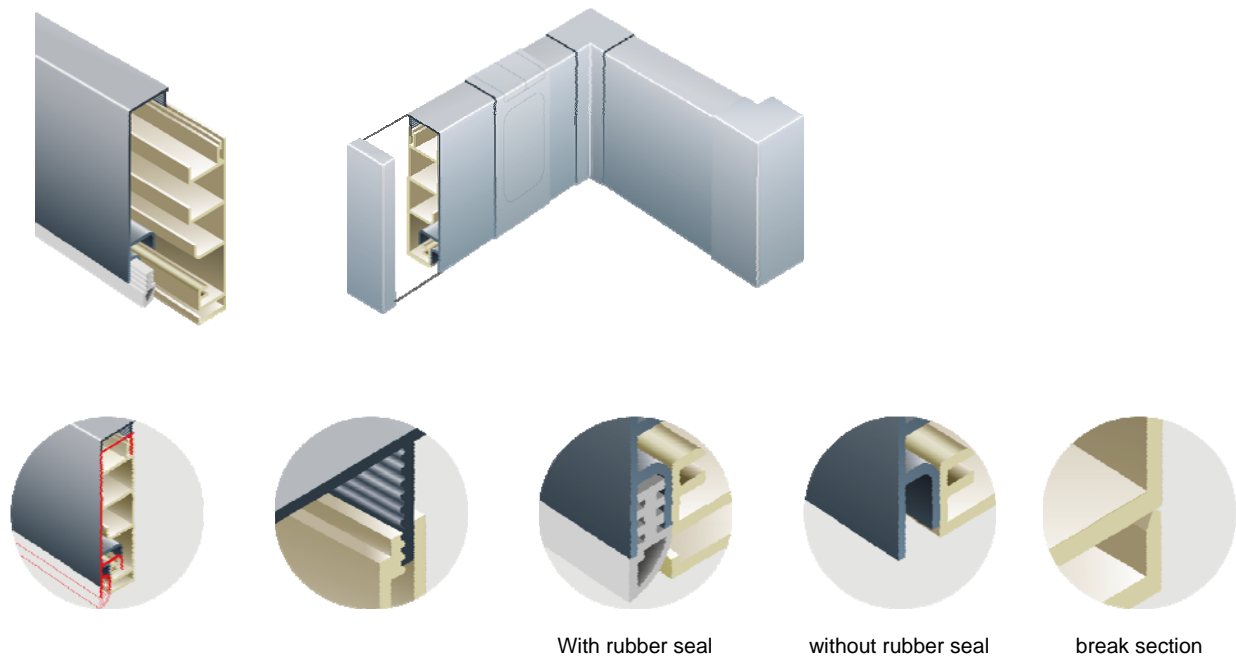
Well thought-out system, with rubber lip and corner pieces

A rubber lip can be inserted in the lower end of the aluminium socket to close the gap if a seal is required between the floor and the skirting board, or if there are any uneven areas in the floor. If the rubber seal is not needed, the lower section of the plastic unit can easily be removed at the pre-marked breaking point, so that the plastic component and the aluminium terminal will still be at the same level, and will sit cleanly and close evenly together. Integrated pre-marked breaking points are provided in the connectors so that the cable can also be inserted and removed cleanly. The exclusive Contego range is rounded off by decorative internal and external corners made of high-quality die-cast aluminium, completing the visually appealing impact of contemporary architecture.

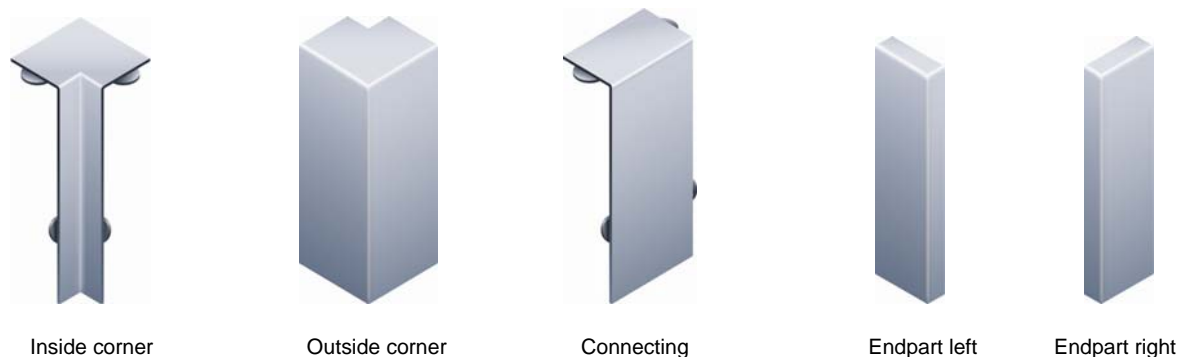
Distribution and availability

The new Contego cable sockets will be available from March 2009. As well as 4-metre long 60x15mm skirting boards, the Contego system also includes end pieces for connection to the left or right, connectors with pre-marked breaking points for cable outlets, internal and external corners and a rubber seal.
